

Little Sellers Art Prize 2022



Conditions of entry and entry form

Budding school aged artists are invited to enter Eurobodalla Shire Council's Little Sellers Art Prize 2022.

This year's prize includes the inaugural Little Sellers Scholarship Program of \$2,000 for an entry of excellence by a year 11 or 12 student, undertaking further studies in visual arts in 2023.

This year's theme is 'Greet the Sun. Face the Moon'. Participants are encouraged to interpret the theme creatively in a way that is meaningful to them.

There are four school year categories:

- Years 1 - 4
- Years 5 - 7
- Years 8 - 10
- Years 11 - 12

Six finalists will be chosen from each school year category, with all entrant submissions being exhibited at the Basil Sellers Exhibition Centre from Saturday 13 – Sunday 21 August 2022.

A winner and a runner up will be chosen from each finalist category. Winners of each category will receive a \$50 voucher and runners up a \$30 voucher to spend on art supplies at Amanda's of Mogo.

The overall winner of the Little Sellers Art Prize will be chosen from the category winners. The winning entrant will receive \$200. The recipient of the Little Sellers scholarship program will receive \$2,000 to assist in further studies in the visual arts field from art collector, patron of the arts and philanthropist, Mr. Basil Sellers. Finalists will also be in the running to win:

- The Eurobodalla Children's Award (Years 1- 7) of \$75 judged by Coordinator Children's Services, Louise Hatton.
- The Eurobodalla Youth Award (Years 8 - 12) of \$75 judged by Community Development and Youth Coordinator, Rhonnie South.

All major prizes are acquisitive and will form part of Council's permanent collection.

- Entries open: Monday 7 March 2022, 8.30am
- Entries close: Friday 24 June 2022, 4.30pm
- Judging period: 4 – 9 July 2022
- Finalists notified by Saturday 30 July 2022
- Winners and recipient of scholarship announced at the Bas Monday 15 August 2022, 10am
- Exhibition dates: Saturday 13 – Sunday 21 August 2022

Conditions of entry

- only one artwork per entrant.
- artwork must be the original work of the entrant.
- artwork must not exceed A3 in size. (42.0mm x 29.7mm) and can be vertical or horizontal.

- artwork must be two dimensional and presented on reasonable quality paper so it can be displayed at the Basil Sellers Exhibition Centre. Please do not use printer or similar paper.
- artwork must be clearly labelled on the back with artist name, age, address, phone number, title of work and the direction the picture should be displayed, ensuring labelling is not visible from the front of your work.
- entrants must allow all works to be reproduced by Eurobodalla Shire Council in print and digital media formats for the purposes of advertising, promotion and documentation of arts and cultural activities occurring within the Shire.
- works can include digital drawings.
- photographic work will not be accepted.

How to enter

- entry forms can be downloaded from the Bas website.
- completed entry forms must include the title of the work, name of the entrant's school and be signed by a parent or legal guardian. Teachers submitting work for their class, bear the responsibility of seeking parental permission.
- artwork should be sent flat; we suggest placing your artwork between two pieces of cardboard.
- council will take all due care of artworks submitted to the Little Sellers Art Prize but takes no responsibility for any loss or damage to artwork whilst in custody or transit. All works will be returned to the entrant's school at the conclusion of the exhibition.

Judging

- six finalists will be chosen from each school year category and will be contacted following the close of judging.
- due to the expected number of entries, only finalists will be notified. If you are not contacted, then your entry is not a finalist this year.
- entries will be judged on merit, originality, and artistic interpretation of the theme 'Greet the Sun. Face the Moon'.
- chance plays no part in the selection of the winners.
- one winner and one runner up will be chosen from the finalists of each category.
- the overall winner will be chosen from the category winners.
- the scholarship recipient will be chosen from the year 11 and 12 category
- the winners of the Eurobodalla Children's and Eurobodalla Youth awards will be chosen from all the finalists.
