

The ever popular biennial ReVive Art Prize returns to Eurobodalla in 2019 at the Basil Sellers exhibition Centre.

ReVive is open to all artists, crafts people and creative makers who reside in Eurobodalla, the Bega Valley or the Snowy Monaro Shires.

Artworks must primarily be created from materials that have been recycled or reclaimed from the waste stream.

There is a \$2500 prize for the winning work, a \$1000 highly commended award and a \$500 People's Choice Award to be won.

Entries close Monday 26 August 2019.

The winner will be announced at the opening night of the exhibition, 6pm Friday 1 November 2019 at the Bas.

## ReVive Art Prize Entry Guidelines

1. The winning entry will receive a \$2500 prize.
2. The runner up will receive a \$1000 prize
3. The winner of the ReVive People's Choice Award will receive \$500.
4. All entrants are restricted to those whose principal place of residence is in Eurobodalla, Bega Valley or Snowy Monaro Shires.
5. The entrant must be the sole originator of the work.
6. Works must be demonstrably produced from 80% or more reclaimed or recycled materials. Works may be in any medium, style or theme.
7. Materials used should be substantially free – obtained from the landfill, found or purchased from Salvos, Vinnies etc.
8. A maximum of 2 entries per artist.
9. Maximum size for 2D works is 180cm x 150cm or equivalent area inclusive of any framing.
10. Maximum size for 3D works is no larger than 150 cm (H) x 50 cm (W) x 50 cm (D) for plinth display.
11. No works to exceed 20kgs.
12. There is a non-refundable entry fee of \$15 per artwork.

Entry fees can be paid:

13. Artists must submit an artist's statement (max 25 words) for each artwork.
14. Each artist must submit one high resolution image (print ready image) of each individual artwork in a jpg format.
15. Each DIGITAL image file (jpg) should be clearly labelled with the TITLE OF WORK ONLY.

16. Digital images will be for viewing, review and selection by the Judge. Entrants are advised to submit high quality accurate images of their work.
17. Entries close 4.30 pm Monday 26 August. No late entries will be accepted.
18. Works will be shortlisted for exhibition and judging by Eurobodalla Shire Council's Coordinator Creative Arts Development.
19. All winning artworks will be selected from the hung exhibition by a judge appointed by Coordinator Creative Arts Development.
20. All works will be judged on the merit of the work. Weight will be given for works where the previous 'life' of the material is visible.
21. The Judge's decision is final and no correspondence regarding their decision will be entered into.
22. All artists entering the ReVive Art Prize give permission for their artwork to be reproduced by print/electronic media for the purposes of advertising, promotion and documentation of arts and cultural activities in the Shire.
23. All entrants will be notified BY email of their selection status.
